This is an invitation for a **vaccination against the coronavirus Covid-19.** Please keep this letter in a safe place. You will find all the important information concerning your vaccination below.

The vaccination is completely **free of charge**.

Why is getting vaccinated important?

- The vaccine offers the best protection against COVID-19. Vaccination activates your body's immune system.
- The vaccine is efficient, safe, and reliable. Every vaccine has been carefully checked and tested.
- The vaccines have also been tested on people with chronic conditions.
- If more than 70% of all people in Belgium get vaccinated, this will help slow the spread of the virus. This will allow us to return to our normal lives sooner.

Where should you get vaccinated?

You can get vaccinated in one of the vaccination centres in the Brussels region, using the proposed list in the appointment system.

When should you get vaccinated?

You can choose two vaccination times.

You have to be available on both dates.

- Surf to https://coronavirus.brussels/nl/afspraak-vaccinatie-covid/, sign in with your vaccination code<VXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX and pick two times.
- If you are having trouble with this, have your family or friends help you.
- You can also call 00 000 00 to make appointments for your two vaccination moments. Write down these two appointments in your agenda.

What should you do on the day of your appointment?

- Bring the **e-ticket** you were given when you made the reservation for your appointments. You can print it out or store it on your smartphone.
- Bring your identity card.
- Wear a face mask: a surgical mask or a cloth mask, not a bandana or scarf.

- Wear clothes that provide easy access to your upper arm.
- Unless you need help to travel, come alone.
- Do not come if you are sick. In case you are, make a new appointment (see above).

Does one of the following situations apply to you?

- You have suffered an **acute or severe allergic reaction** to a previous vaccine or you have required urgent medical attention after the administration of a drug. Talk about this with your doctor.
- You're currently sick (with a fever above 38°C). Make a new appointment for your vaccination when you are fully recovered.
- You have tested positive for **corona** and you **didn't fall sick in the 14 days after.** You can safely make an appointment.
- You have tested positive for corona and you have fallen sick in the 14 days after, or are still sick now: wait for 14 days after full recovery to make an appointment.
- Pregnancy is not a contraindication. If so desired, vaccination can be considered in specific cases, in consultation with your treating physician.
